



NATIONAL FAUNA RESERVE EDUARDO AVAROA

The Eduardo Avaroa Reserve, located south of Potosí department and bordering on the Salar territory, is one of the regions of greatest scenic beauty. The vegetation is characterized by the strong presence of grass grasses (straw brava) that in some plains and slopes form semicircles. The fauna is characterized by the presence of singular species that adapted to the extreme life conditions of the region, some of them in extinction danger. There are 80 species of birds of which the most representative are the three species of flamingos that inhabit the reserve. There are also 23 species of mammals that thrive in the reserve among which are: vicuñas, pumas, Andean foxes, and vizcachas. A magnificent place safety pin when visiting Bolivia.



TREK PALCA CANYON

Description:

In the morning, departure by car to the small community of Palca, two hours away through the Illimani mountain, 6480mts s.n.m. On the way you will see multicolored flowers adorn the landscape of this rural area. Arrival and start of the trek for about three hours until you reach a warm area with crystalline rivers that moisten this valley with fertile soil. Rest and time for snack. Return to the city of La Paz in private mobility.
